(Singing.) ONE LITTLE WISH AND LO A HOPELESS WORLD OF "NO" BRAGS A MILLION DOORWAYS TO EXPLORE. ONE LITTLE WISH AND OH A GOWN THAT WILL NOT FLOW BECOMES A SILKEN SEA WITHOUT A SHORE.

ONE LITTLE WISH, A SINGLE ONE, CAN HIDE THE MOON BEHIND THE SUN AND MAKE THE SUNSHINE NEVER UNSHINE NIGHT OR DAY.

SO TRY A WISH. WHO NEEDS A TON? ONE MAKES THE WHOLE WORLD RUN. MAKE ONE LITTLE WISH AND IT IS DONE.
